MONTHLY TUITION FEES


Yearly tuition is divided into ten (10) equal monthly payments and is due at the beginning of each month. The deposit was due in May. A tuition payment of \$263.00 (T/TH program) and \$364.00 (MWF program) is due at the beginning of each month September-May. If for any reason your monthly tuition is going to be late, please let me know. We will bill you through the brightwheel app. You may pay by check if you prefer. If you set it up through your bank as a withdrawal, Busy Bees will pay the processing fee. If you pay by credit card, a processing fee will be added to your bill.

IN-HOUSE FIELD TRIPS 2025-2026

We are planning monthly field trips for the 2025-2026 school year. All of our field trips are in-house, where educational and entertainment programs visit with us. We are looking forward to puppeteers, storytellers, zoo shows, dancers, musicians and more! An annual fee of \$60.00 is due on/before October 1. This fee covers all in-house field trips. OPEN HOUSE AT BUSY BEES

T/TH CLASS SCHEDULE

We will divide the class for the first two mornings of school in our T-TH program in order to make the transition easier for the children.

- Tuesday, September 9th 2025 children with last names beginning with the letters A-P will come to school. Parents, you may bring your children into school on this morning and stay for 10-15 minutes at which time you will say your good-byes.
- Thursday, September 11th 2025 children with last names beginning with the letters, R-Z will join us for the morning. Parents, you may bring your children into school on these mornings and stay for 10-15 minutes at which time you will say your good-byes.
- Tuesday, September 16th 2025 we will have our first full T-TH class together.

MWF CLASS SCHEDULE

Monday, September 8th, 2025 will be our first school day for our M-W-F class. You may bring your children into school on the first morning and stay a few minutes and say your good-byes.
