COLD WEATHER PREPARATION

The cold weather is here! We love to play outside, even if it is cold and snowy. Please pack warm jackets, hats and mittens every cold day. If there is snow, please pack snow gear. Please help your child practice putting on his/her jacket and snow gear. Getting snow gear on all of the children takes time and patience. I cannot stress enough the importance of labeling clothes, recognizing their belongings and practicing getting dressed for snow. Gloves are very tricky to get on, unless your child can put his/her gloves on easily his/herself, please send mittens. Please put your child's name on all outdoor clothing. We have permanent markers above the cubbies if you need them. We would appreciate it if you could walk your child to his/her cubby in the morning before dropping off into a classroom. It helps them to see where their hats, mittens, and belongings all are when we get ready for the playground. Thank you!

A NICE PLACE TO EXPLORE: Brown Farm Trailhead

Begin from the trailhead and parking area at 64 Hampden Road. There is an informational kiosk at the trailhead. Loop counterclockwise through the woodlands north of the farm area, behind the historic barn. This park is open from dawn until dusk daily. This is a perfect stroll for the entire family to enjoy some fresh air and adventure!

SECOND STEP:

The children in our MWF class have been having *Second Step* lessons with Mrs. Manley every Wednesday. The *Second Step* Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) Program helps children make progress with emotion management, situational awareness and academic achievement. The curriculum is presented through music, games, puppetry and conversation about picture cards.

So far, our *Second Step* lessons have focused on skills for learning. The children have discussed how to welcome new friends to class, focus attention, listen, follow directions, and ask for what they need or want. We are currently working on identifying our feelings by using and observing facial expressions. They enjoy learning along with puppets, Gus and Ava. The lessons in this unit will help set the foundation for future learning.
